Covid-19 Self-Screening
For Face-to-Face Small Group Gatherings

To honor our covenant to each other and recognize our responsibility to care for and protect the most vulnerable among us, persons must self-screen before attending face-to-face gatherings at UU Casper.

- Persons should not attend face-to-face gatherings if they:
 - ✓ Have tested positive for covid-19 and have not been declared as recovered by medical professionals.
 - ✓ Have had close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with Covid-19 within the last 14 days
 - ✓ Have experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms in the last 14 days (fever, cough, headache, shortness of breath or other respiratory problem).
 - ✓ Have traveled out of state during the last 14 days.
- Persons at high-risk for COVID-19 are discouraged from attending face-to-face gatherings in the building.
- Thank you for complying with UU Casper's posted Covid -19 procedures while you are attending face-to-face gatherings at UU Casper.
